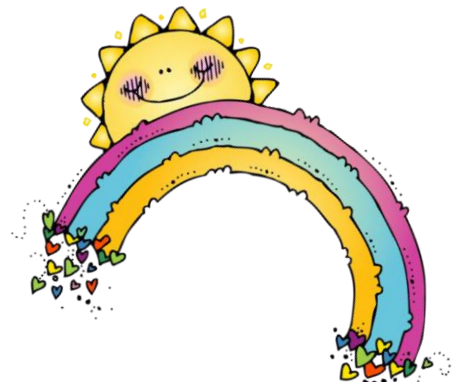
March Task Card #3

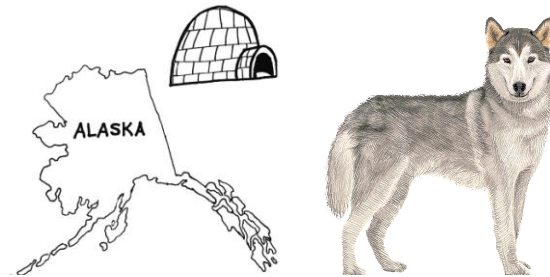
March Task Card #5

March is Women's History Month. Research and create the ABC'S of Famous Women in History. Don't forget to include what they did.



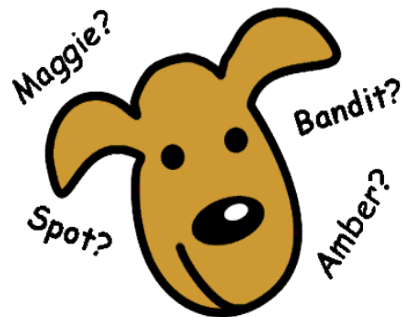
March Task Card #6

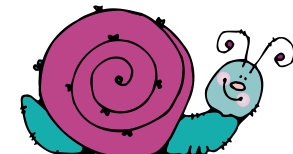
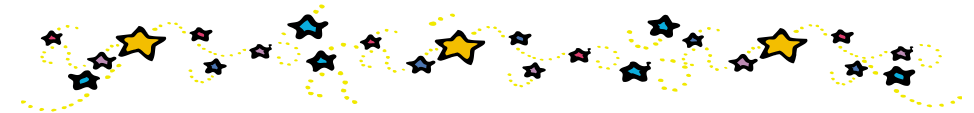
March Task Card #11

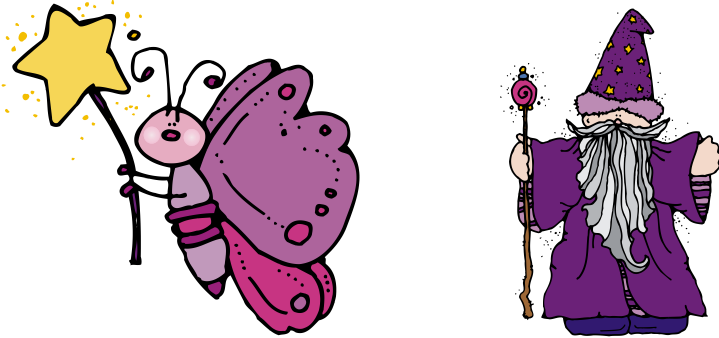
March Task Card #12

March begins new life and tons of new bugs are prowling around. Research different types of bugs and draw pictures to go along with them. You can make a list of bugs and describe them too.



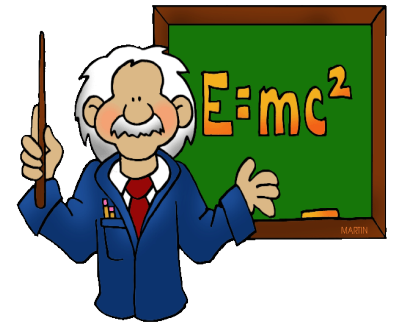
March Task Card #13

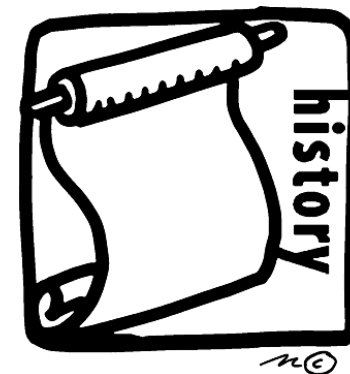
March Task Card #15

March 17th is St. Patrick's Day. Name as many things that you can think of that are **ALWAYS** green. Can you think of at least 30?



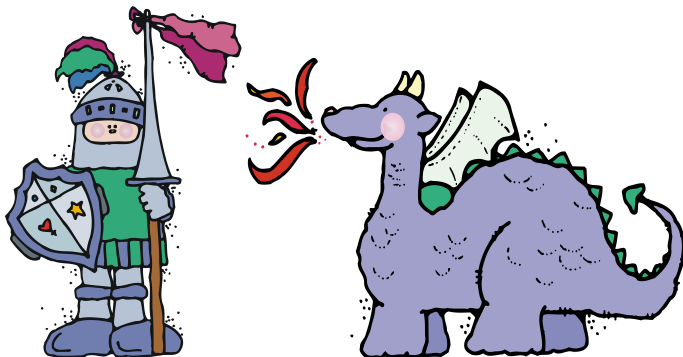
March Task Card #18
